Approval of Minutes for the March 18, 2021 Regular Meeting

Director Trevor Miller presented a slideshow on the Bond Budget Update from Belli Architectural Group for Branciforte Middle School, Harbor High School, and general District-wide projects.

Bond Oversight Committee Annual Report

Assistant Superintendent Monreal stated that the Annual Report will be sent out for the committee to review and approve with signatures and will then be presented to the Board of Education for Santa Cruz City Schools. Mr. Miller reviewed the status of each of the individual sites, as well as specifics regarding classroom modernization.

Bond Budget Update

Trevor Miller presented bond budget updates from Bartos Architecture for Measures A and B. Measure A has a current remaining balance of \$51,936,509 and Measure B has a current remaining balance of \$3,171,635. Branciforte Middle Schools has spent 42% of their budget. Mission Hill Middle School has spent 41% of their budget Harbor High School has spent 93% of their budget. Santa Cruz High School has spent 35% of their budget. Soquel High School has spent 89% of their budget. Bay View Elementary has spent 92% of their budget. DeLaveaga Elementary has spent 92% of their budget. Gault Elementary has spent 22% of their budget. Natural Bridges has spent all of its budget. Westlake has spent 33% of their budget. The Branciforte Small Schools campus has spent 75% of their budget
